1. Open Forum

Dan Fleury discussed with the Board the Boy Scouts several projects

Selectmen Tinio asked if they work the same as the wind and you sell the electricity back to the grid, Ms. Mazar will research this and get back to the Board. Selectmen Tinio asked if the solar panel can be put under the wind tower.
- Brownfield cleanup application – Mr. Pleau discussed the deadline for the grant
- French Drain – Mr. Pleau discussed with the Board the French Drain & Moisture Barrier completion, the Town Clerk will have her records restored in the following weeks.

5. Old Business

- Building Fees discussion – Chairman Ammendolia is satisfied with current economy with the rates, Selectmen Breen agreed. Selectmen Tinio completely disagreed. Chairman Ammendolia believes the fees were brought in line with other towns. Selectmen Breen would like to see what other communities are doing that do not have water and sewer. Chairman Ammendolia would like to table the discussion and take under advisement.
