6. Proclamation

Selectmen Ken O'Brien read the Eagle Boy Scout proclamation for A.J. Tetreault. The Board signed the Proclamation and congratulated young Tetreault.

7. Class II-Excess Vehicles

The Board discussed excess vehicles and took no action. Chairman Shaheen does not want to act on this issue unless there is a complaint and is not alarmed.

8. Forest Park Roads

The Board discussed with the Kathy Daniels, Kevin Rudden, Alan Tetreault and Steve Hackenson the roads in Forest Park and whether the town should take over the plowing & sanding of these roads even though they have not been accepted yet.

Steve Hackenson stated that all items on the punch list have been completed except a section of road which Planning Board and Highway Surveyor are not satisfied with.

Kathy & Kevin of the Planning Board stated that Steve had not called the town engineer for a final inspection. There are still some joints that need to be re-mortared. A resident showed some glass that she had found in the area between the sidewalk and road that has not been cleaned up. Steve states he will go back and remove the glass. Planning Board is not in favor of the town taking over the plowing and sanding before acceptance. It sets a bad precedent. If the town does take over the plowing and sanding, the town should be reimbursed from the bond.

Sharon stated that this was an unusual situation. It has been a long time and she considers this a safety issue. The bankruptcy is not a neighbor issue or Hackenson's issue.
