**Motion by Selectman Ammendolia to open the hearing, Selectmen Breen 2<sup>nd</sup>. Passes (3-0).**

Dept. Chief Poirier addresses the board in regards to his favorable opinion of the application.

**Motion by Selectman Ammendolia to open and suspended the Kennel license hearing, Selectmen Breen 2<sup>nd</sup>. Passes (3-0). (7:45)**

Andrea Darien questions the Board and Dept. Chief in regards to safety issues surrounding the license.

**At 7:56 motion by Selectman Ammendolia to close the hearing, Selectmen Breen 2<sup>nd</sup>. Passes (3-0).**

**Motion by Selectman Ammendolia to approve the Imperial Ford flammable liquids permit, Selectmen Breen 2<sup>nd</sup>. Passes (3-0).**

### **Kennel license hearing (continuation)**

## **Open Forum**

**Motion by Selectman Ammendolia to approve August 25, 2007 for Troop 44 Flea Market on town-owned Fino property, with rain date of August 26, 2007, Selectmen Breen 2<sup>nd</sup>. All in favor.**

**Motion by Selectman Ammendolia to approve a hawkers and Peddler's License August 25, 2007 to August 26, 2007 for Troop 44 Flea Market on town-owned Fino property, and to wave the fee, Selectmen Breen 2<sup>nd</sup>. All in favor.**

Richard Skinner, Hartford Avenue East, discussed safety concerns and citation procedures in Mendon and specifically on Hartford Avenue East.

## **Administrative Issues**

Board discusses appointment of FY08 Town Counsel. Selectman Breen states he will abstain from the vote, as he was absent from the interviews.

**Motion by Selectman Ammendolia to appoint Robert S. Mangiaratti, Esq. Murphy, Hesse, Toomey & Lehane, LLP as Mendon Town Counsel for a term to expire June 30, 2008, Chairman Tinio steps down to 2<sup>nd</sup>. Passes (2-0-1, Breen abstains).**

**Motion by Selectman Breen to appoint Kevin Fleming as Electrical Inspector for a term to expire June 30, 2008, Chairman Tinio steps down 2<sup>nd</sup>. Passes (2-1, Ammendolia against).**

Mr. McCue thanks James and Vivian Podsiadlo of 8 Forest Park Drive for their donation to the town of four computers.

**Motion by Selectman Ammendolia to approve the minutes of June 19, 2007, Chairman Tinio steps down to 2<sup>nd</sup>. Passes (2-0-1 Breen abstains).**

**Motion by Selectman Ammendolia to adjourn, Selectmen Breen 2<sup>nd</sup>. Passes (3-0).**
