ARTICLE 1 Voted to transfer \$720 from Conservation Wetlands Account to Conservation Salaries & Wages (line item 171A).

ARTICLE 2 Voted to transfer \$2750 from Finance Committee Reserve For Salary Negotiations (line item 131C) to Police Department Wages - Clerk (line item 210F).

ARTICLE 3 Voted to transfer \$2400 from Free Cash to Police Department Quinn Bill (line item 210J).

ARTICLE 4 Voted to transfer \$4000 from Free Cash to Fire Department Call Salaries & Wages (line item 220A2).

ARTICLE 5 Vote to transfer \$22,750 from Police Dept. Full Time Salary & Wages (Line Item 210C) and \$10,000 from Police Dept. Overtime (Line Item 210E), and \$13,000 from Fire Dept. Expenses (Line Item 220B) and \$4,250 from Free Cash totaling \$50,000 to Fire Department Full Time Salaries & Wages (line item 220A4).

ARTICLE 6 Voted to transfer \$9000 from Finance Committee Reserve for Salary Negotiations and \$1000 from Free Cash to Fire Department Overtime Salaries & Wages (line item 220A5).

ARTICLE 7 Voted to transfer \$5000 from Free Cash to Dispatching Salaries & Wages (line item 299A).
UNANIMOUS VOICE VOTE

ARTICLE 8 Voted to transfer \$413 from Free Cash to Worker's Compensation (line item 912A).
MAJORITY VOICE VOTE

ARTICLE 9 Voted to transfer \$2026 from Free Cash to Liability (line item 945A).
UNANIMOUS VOICE VOTE

ARTICLE 10 Voted to Passover this article to transfer a sum of money from available funds to Reserve (line item 131B).
MAJORITY VOICE VOTE
